It is important to understand that once the thermostat is programmed, the heating and cooling system is automatically activated in response to programmed requirements. The first step to programming the programmable Honeywell thermostat is to press the clock button and use the directional arrow to advance at the right time of day and then press done, which is located on the bottom right side of the device. Then click the system button and set the day of the week. To set a date, click on the central blank button at the bottom of the screen, and then select the system button before displaying the desired function. For example, click the system button three times to use the automatic programming feature. Use the schedule button and then the editing button, both of which are located at the bottom of the screen, to change settings for each day. Select the day of the week that needs to be edited, and press the wake-up button, along with the directional arrow, to set the desired temperature for that particular day of the week. Click to complete the editing and save the programming.
